## RWE publishes first Energy Trade Glossary

Prepared by RWE Turkey, Turkey's first "Energy Trade Glossary" was presented to the energy market. The glossary includes definitions of common terms in the field of energy trade, and provides information on the energy trading.

Explaining that the Turkish market is in a rapid state of growth and liberalization, **Andreas Radmacher, CEO of RWE Turkey**, said that the market was becoming more competitive, resilient and efficient with every passing day. **Radmacher** continued *"The energy market in Turkey is becoming liberalised. Liberal markets bring a set of new terms to our sector. Derived mostly from the financial sector, these terms will be better explained by and understood with the Energy Trade Glossary."*

The glossary is based on the terms used in the German market, one of the most liquid and well-functioning markets in Europe. It has been published in German, English and Turkish. **Bakatjan Sandalkhan, Vice President of Energy Markets and Sales of RWE Turkey** continued, *"We believe that Turkey will play a leading role as an energy hub in the region. The establishment of an Energy Exchange will reinforce this position. We hope that the general information on energy trading, given in the last section of the glossary, will facilitate this transition."*

The Energy Trade Glossary contains approx. 270 entries. The terms are categorized under headings such as gas, electricity, coal, carbon and emissions, and transportation.
