Back to School gift from RWE & Turcas

“Energy Box” project of RWE & Turcas continues successfully on its 3rd year. 600 first grade students from Honaz will receive energy box gift packs, a project to educate school children on energy efficiency. Denizli Power Plant Director Seyhan Karabulut met with children at Kaklık Elementary School on September 10 and started the distribution for 2014-2015 academic year. Energy boxes contain school equipment, a high-visibility bracelet and a storybook on energy efficiency for the whole family. Students love the gift packs which also serve as lunch boxes.

The Energy Box project started in the 2012-2013 academic year to educate children on energy resources and how to use energy efficiently. The storybook included in the energy box contains simple, fun tips for children and their parents to conserve energy and achieve energy efficiency in general. RWE & Turcas remain committed to supporting education and social opportunities for children, and will continue to give out energy boxes in future academic years.
