RWE & TURCAS Given "New Investment Success Award" by Denizli

RWE & TURCAS Güney Elektrik Üretim A.Ş. received first prize with their 500 million-Euro investment in Denizli in the "New Investment Success" category of the Major Players in Denizli Economy Awards given by the Denizli Chamber of Commerce, Denizli Chamber of Industry and the Denizli Mercantile Exchange.

RWE & TURCAS Managing Director Hermann-Josef Thieltges received the prize from the Mayor of Denizli Osman Zolan at the awards ceremony held at the Pamukkale University on March 28 and explained that the 500 million-Euro RWE & TURCAS Natural Gas Combined Cycle Power Plant played a major role in meeting the energy needs of the region. Thieltges added that the power plant would contribute to the regional economy with the employment opportunities it creates during construction and when commissioned. Thieltges said, "The plant has an estimated life of 40 years, during which it will offer a consistent and long-term economic potential to the Denizli and Kaklık region."

The 775 MW RWE & TURCAS Denizli Natural Gas Combined Cycle Power Plant will be commissioned in 2012, and is expected to provide power to 3.5 million households. The plant will also be one of the most modern and environmentally friendly plants in Turkey.
